

Report that I, D. Carlos de la Chayse, Assistant to the Magistrate of this City, as Commissioner appointed by the Illustrious Municipal Council for the Supervision of Public Provisions in the present month, form of the amount of money that has been produced by the tax on beeves distributed to butchers markets, stalls or tables, rent of rooms, and other items. To wit:

As shown by the preceding report, the total produced amounts to three hundred forty-eight pesos five reales, minus one peso of expenses incurred in the maintenance of the Granary, there remain on hand to the Credit of the Superintendent of Estates, D. Juan de Castanedo, three hundred forty-seven pesos five reales, as is evidenced by the previously cited Report, and in order that it be vouched for I sign it in the City of New Orleans, on the 30th of September, 1794.
