Know all Men by these presents:

THAT WE,

In the City of New-Orleans, acting under the Mayor's License, and

of the said City, as Security, are jointly

held and firmly bound unto Municipality No. One of the said City, in the full and just sum of One Thousand Dollars, current money of this State, and for the payment whereof we bind ourselves, and each of us, our heirs, executors and administrators, firmly by these Presents.

Now, therefore, the Condition of the above Obligation is such, That if the above named Principal of the Present Bond, shall well and truly perform and faithfully discharge all the duties imposed on all Coffee-House, Cabaret, Tavern Keepers, &c., by the Ordinances of the General Council and Regulations of Police of the said Municipality, and shall, at the beginning of each Quarter, that is to say, on the First Day of January, April, July and October, pay into the hands of the Collector of the said Municipality, the amount of the Tax of *300* DOLLARS per annum, imposed by the aforesaid General Council, on said Keepers, &c., or such part of the said Tax as may then be due, or the amount of Fines and other Penalties incurred for contravention of the said Ordinances and Regulations; then the above obligation shall be void and of no effect, otherwise to be in full force and virtue in law until the same is duly cancelled at the Mayoralty.
