

I Now all Men by these presents that I
Daniel S. Norton of the County of Attachapas
Territory of Orleans have this Day sold unto
Asa Norton of the County of aforesaid One certain
Negro boy to me belonging named George aged
about seventeen years for and in the Consideration
of the sum of five hundred Dollars for which he
the said Asa has assumed to pay Three hundred
and ten Dollars to M^r Care Montague of the
State of Kentucky who holds an obligation
signed by me the said Daniel & the said Asa

And the said Asa has also executed to me his note
for the sum of Two hundred & forty Dollars
payable the first Day of May next which
two sums of Three hundred & ten Dollars and
Two hundred & forty Dollars when paid will
be in full payment for the said boy

And I do Covenant to & with the said Asa
that I am the true & lawful Owner and
have good right & lawful authority to sell the
above property & do hereby convey all my

right title & interest to the said boy Making him
however subject to the payment of the above sum
of five hundred & fifty Dollars & I warrant the boy
to be blind and healthy
