Ransom of Curry

Know all men by these presents, that we
Silas N. Thompson and John M. Thompson
are held and firmly bound unto Ransom J. Causey
in the sum of Three thousand Six hundred Dollars,
for the payment whereof well and truly to be
made we bind ourselves, our heirs executors and
administrators jointly and severally, firmly by these
presents. Signed by us and sealed with our seals,
and dated this 10th day of August A. D. 1858.

The condition of the above obligation is, that
whereas certain differences have arisen between said
Causey late guardian of Elijah J. Thompson a minor
and his said ward relative to the matters of
said guardianship, and relative to said Causey's
administration ^{and sale} of the ^{real} estate of Elijah Thompson
deceased, which differences have been compromised
by said Causey securing to said Silas N. Thompson
the present guardian of said Elijah J. Thompson
the sum of Eighteen hundred Dollars which sum
also pays and cancels the decree of the Probate
Court on said Causey's final settlement of said
guardianship; Now if the said Silas N. Thompson
shall forever save harmless and indemnify said
Causey late administrator and guardian as aforesaid
from and against any and all claim or demand
by said Elijah J. Thompson his heirs executors admini-
strators or assigns on account of said guardianship
or on account of any money, land, slaves or other
property belonging or allowed to belong either legally or
equitably to said Elijah J. or on account of the
~~administration~~ ^{sale} by said Causey of the ^{real} estate of
said Elijah Thompson deceased, then the preceding
obligation to be void; otherwise to be and remain
in full force and virtue. Nothing herein contained

is in any way to affect the claim of said Elijah J. Thompson to his interest in certain Slaves, conveyed by the mother of said Elijah J. in her life time and now held by said Curry under the married woman's law.
