THE CABILDO COURTYARD

709 CHARTRES STREET, VIEUX CARRÉ, NEW ORLEANS

The first Cabildo or "Capitol" fell a prey to the disastrous fire of 1788. Present building was begun in 1795 by Don Andres Almonester y Roxas. He supplied the finances, was the architect and constructed the building. The architecture is distinctly Spanish.

The actual transfers of the Louisiana Territory in 1803, from Spain to France, and twenty days later from France to the United States, took place in this building.
