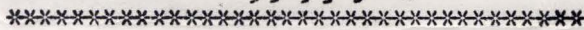
Men, Women and Children - let's wear old clothes, with new Dignity especially on Sunday, December 15, 1963.

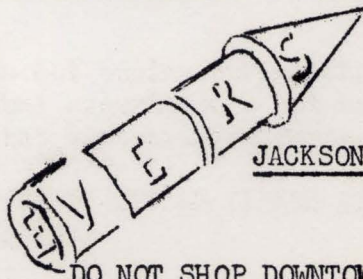
