Dear Mr. Toole:


I am very glad to inform you that President Harris has awarded you a Special Scholarship for 1956-57 at Tulane University. This award is based on evidence of your need, your leadership qualities, and your potentialities for taking full advantage of the opportunities offered at Tulane. Your scholarship will be renewed each year for the following three undergraduate years, provided, of course, that you carry the normal academic program of studies and do the quality of work expected of a good student.

This scholarship exempts you from the tuition payment of \$550 per year which will amount to \$2200 for four years of undergraduate work. It does not exempt you from paying the University fee of \$100 per year. I am sure you know that the real worth of such a scholarship scarcely can be calculated.

In consideration of the value of this scholarship, you will be expected to contribute as much as five hours of work each week to the University. Please advise me by letter at your early convenience if you will accept this Special Scholarship. I sincerely hope you will do so.
