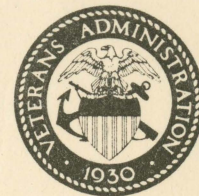

An acknowledgment of this letter is not required if no adjustment in the account is in order.

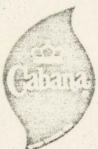
