I found the Rev Mr Linley here who informed me that he got 40 Slaves Liberated which were sent into New Orleans and claimed as Spanish Property the Judge of the U S Court Decided that they could not be claimed as Spanish Property as the Law of Spain prohibited the Importation of Slaves they were given up and sent back I Liberated by the U S Government

I cannot but hope you will be successful in behalf of our much abused African Brethren
