Dear Brother

Enclosed are three dollars - Two dollars

of which you will appropriate to the defence of the A. M. A. Coptious & the other dollar will pay for my "Reporter". I have before contributed to the com<sup>tee</sup> at New Haven for the in-struction of the A. M. A. Coptious - I have not as yet contri-buted to the funds of the 'A. M. A. Anti Slavery Society'; - The reason is not a want of confidence or interest in that associa-tion - but during a short time previous to the Annual Meeting contributed to the Am Society \$100 one hundred dollars - I have not had funds that I could consistently appropriate to this object more than what I thought to use near home in aiding the State Socy &c. -

As considerable has been published in the papers respect-ing the memorial of sundry Cong<sup>o</sup> & Presb<sup>o</sup> ministers to the A. B. C. F. M. & as that memorial has not been published, & as the Synod's ground of it in the Evangelist, altho' quite fair, does not in my judge-ment do it full justice, I enclose you a copy of the memorial to dispose of at your discretion - I write to Bro Leavitt expressing a hope that, if he published any thing in response to it, he would give the me-morial with the report of the com<sup>tee</sup> - You may consult him if you please - & as you <sup>now</sup> have <sup>both</sup> the report & ~~as~~ your own memorial I leave the subject in your hands
