I have the pleasure of again sending some money for the aid and assistance of the poor Africans. This as what I sent before is left to the discretion of the Committee to apply as they think best. I enclose five Dollars sent \$2.50 by Charles Wright and \$2.50 by Parvin Wright for the use of the Africans of the Amistad - the pamphlets sent to J P Smith & myself were received also the Anti-S Reporter - the letter of Judge Jay in last Month's Reporter is calculated to do much good I think - and gives a full explanation of the case to such as have not understood it. if they are to be obtained I would be glad to have several copies of that letter to distribute.
