-warded to you) That the grateful thanks of the
Colored people of Cincinnati are hereby tendered to
those noble, indefatigable and steadfast friends
of our people in the Eastern States whose Philanth-
-ropic efforts in behalf of our brethren the Amistad
Captives has thus far preserved them from the grasp
