Dear Sir

I have received your favor of the 24<sup>th</sup> with check for 117.<sup>81</sup>/<sub>100</sub> Dollars from A Tappan & Co which is credited on my account against John Cook & others creditors of Lewis & Holt, for which & for the trouble you have had in bringing this matter to a settlement I thank you.

Your check for fifty dollars on account of the Amistad case I acknowledged on the 24<sup>th</sup>. It did not reach me till some days after its date.

I shall probably leave here for Washington on Thursday the 7<sup>th</sup> of Jan'y, so as to be there at the opening of the Court. Saturdays are motion days & I shall hope to be able to make the motion as early as Saturday of the first week, & if possible before that time.

I do not yet receive the copies from Washington & will thank you to send me by Steam boat, the copies which I left with Mr. Sedgwick if you have them.
