break for Commissioned officers
Drill to be guard mounting

Company and regiment
drill from 8^o @ 11^o to 12^o
4. 1/2 from 12^o till 5. 1/2 P. M.
Dress parade 5/4.

Retreat at sunrise
Battalion at 8 o'clock.

Tell allie we have a drummer
Boy here that is only six years
old and small of his age that
can play as well as any in
camp. He is about as tall
as allie and has a little drum
made for him and is quite
a curiosity among the boys.
I must close this in time for
church (or I forget we have preaching
three to day)
