Durell, on THURSDAY, 14th; at the Town House, on FRIDAY, 15th—from 10 A.M. to 4 P.M., each day, for the purpose of receiving all unpaid taxes. N. B.—All taxes not so paid will be subject to cost and interest.

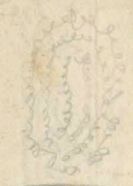
