

JR. PHILHARMONIC AUDITIONS SET

The annual statewide auditions of the Junior Philharmonic Society of New Orleans will be held at 9:45 a. m. Saturday at Dixon Hall, Newcomb college campus.

Auditionists are divided into groups, the Young Artists, the Intermediate and the Junior Group and each must be a member of the Junior Philharmonic society. There is no minimum age limit, but the oldest must be under 26 years of age.

Each youngster must be prepared to perform three selections from memory. Keys will

be presented to those who both audition and perform in recital. Pianists, violinists, other instrumentalists, dancers, vocalists and choral groups will be heard.

Winners are selected on the basis of their age and proficiency, not in competition with one another. Judges will select students who will be given the opportunity to appear in planned recitals.
