Winners were selected Saturday in the Junior Philharmonic statewide auditions at Dixon Hall on the Newcomb College campus.

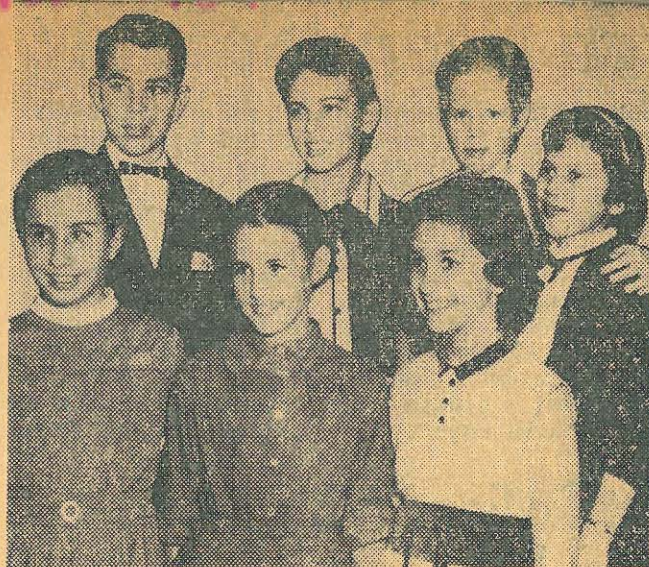
Named were:
